This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Did the Court of Appeals err in affirming the trial court's ruling that Bourassa lacks standing to seek to suppress the intercepted phone conversations?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
